HAM cohort

HPPA cohort

- Pair with an experienced physician leader to work with throughout the program year.
- Gain insight into health policy processes in organized medicine, as well as in state and federal government.
- Develop leadership skills and competencies to become health policy and patient advocates in their fields and beyond.
- Attend the National Advocacy Conference (NAC) or the Medical Student Advocacy Conference (MAC), in addition to the other in-person events, virtual education sessions and mentorship opportunities.
