The 2024 Interim Meeting of the AMA Academic Physicians Section (APS) was held November 8 in Orlando with approximately 40 academic physician members in attendance from academic institutions across the country.

The APS education session, "Medical Education and Health Equity in the Era of Augmented Intelligence," covered approaches to support the ethical and equitable use of AI in medical education and clinical care. REPORT AND RESOLUTION OVERVIEW

<u>Board of Trustees Report 24-I-24</u>, "Physicians Arrested for Non-Violent Crimes While Engaged in Public Protests," recommended that APS Resolution 009-I-23 be adopted as amended. Board of Trustees Report 24 was adopted with limited, yet unanimous support.
