Subject: Physician Payments for Inflationary Updates That Were Never Actualized

Whereas, physician practices have struggled to balance their budgets due to diminishing reimbursement despite inflation resulting in negative operating margins; and

Whereas, since 2000, other healthcare lines of business have received inflationary updates but physicians have not; and

Whereas, physician practices are still struggling from damages from the Covid-19 pandemic and recoupment of resources unjustly denied for services rendered would strengthen practices and the healthcare economy; and

Whereas, recoupment of previously denied funds in lump sum will prevent practice closures in the near future and is congruent with the American concept of justice; therefore be it

RESOLVED, that our American Medical Association advocate for lump sum payments made directly to physicians for inflationary updates never actualized by public payors going back to the year 2000 (Directive to Take Action).
