Per AMA Bylaw, 2.4.3, "Delegates and alternate delegates shall be elected by the Resident and Fellow Section in accordance with procedures adopted by the Section. Each delegate and alternate delegate must receive written endorsement from a society or organization currently seated in the House of Delegates and in accordance with procedures adopted by the Resident and Fellow Section and approved by the Board of Trustees."

Per AMA Bylaw 2.10.9, "Each delegate from the Resident and Fellow Section shall be seated with the physician's endorsing society or organization. In the case where a delegate has been endorsed by multiple entities, the delegate must choose, prior to the election, with which delegation the delegate wishes to be seated. Alternate or substitute delegates shall be assigned to the original delegate's seat location during the time they are seated for the original delegate."

All applicants who receive and submit proof of endorsement prior to the election will have their names **bolded** on the voting ballot to signify that their endorsement has been confirmed. Candidates will have 30 days post-election to confirm their endorsement.


